General Rules & Information

Description/Purpose



The purpose of "Stallion Review" is to showcase stallions of all breeds of equine to both prospective breeders and equine enthusiasts wishing to learn about each breed. These fine representatives will be stalled in a designated "Stallion Review" area. This area will be limited as space allows. A daily "Review of Stallions" will occur in one of the arenas to allow the spectators to see the stallions out of their stalls and hear a short 2-3 minute description of the breed and stallion. Participation in this area will not only provide contacts for potential breeders, but also serve as an educational opportunity to promote your chosen breed to the public. No sales, with the exception of breeding contracts, is permitted in the barn.

Selection

Applications are to be completed and submitted to the Northwest Horse Fair & Expo by February 1, along with non-refundable payment in full. Event management retains the right to limit the number of representatives per breed or to decline or prohibit participation by an animal/farm/owner, which in the management's opinion is not suitable to and in keeping with the character of The Northwest Horse Fair & Expo. Further, the event management retains the right to dismiss from the event an animal/farm/owner/ individual without refund, which in the management's opinion imposes safety concerns for itself or others, and/or is not suitable to and in keeping with the character of the event.

Fees & Passes

- The fee for "Stallion Review" is \$250.00 per stallion enrolled (stalled and exhibited), which includes one (1) 10 x 10 stallion stall, one (1) 10 x 10 adjoining hospitality area and two (2) admission passes per day. Electricity is available for your hospitality area for \$30.00.
- All fees, including any late script fees, must be paid in full prior to set up at the Northwest Horse Fair & Expo.
- Additional passes may be purchased until February 15. Limit 4 passes per day. <u>Every exhibitor and attendee must have a pass</u> even those staying on grounds for the weekend. If wristbands are provided they MUST be worn or they are not valid for admission and will be confiscated.
- In the event you will not see all exhibitors prior to Friday morning of the event, you may leave passes with the stall office the night before with a list of names of the individuals who will be arriving to claim these passes.
- All passes will be left at the exhibitors/vendors entrance near the back of the facility.
- If passes are not left the night before, any exhibitors without passes must pay full price at the gate.
- If staying overnight on Sunday, an additional fee of \$20 will be due. This fee can be paid on Sunday to the stall office.

Scripts

- Programs are to be 2-3 minutes in length and are not to exceed three (3) minutes.
- Scripts should primarily consist of a history/description of the breed and/or discipline being represented. A BRIEF description of the stallion and farm should also be included. From audience feedback, extensive discussion of lineage can be monotonous in the script just hit the highlights if applicable.
- Phonetic spelling of difficult words and/or names is greatly appreciated. We also encourage you to sit with our announcers prior to your demonstration to be sure they can easily pronounce difficult names.
- Programs are subject to editing by the event management and **must be received by February 1**. No changes to scripts will be accepted after February 1. Script does not have to accompany application if the application is submitted prior to application deadline. We prefer scripts be emailed to the office in a word format that can be easily edited. It is YOUR responsibility to confirm the receipt of the script in the office by the deadline. If you email the script and do not receive a confirmation reply, be sure to follow up with our office right away.

- Only the horse(s) enrolled on "Stallion Review" are allowed to exhibit during the daily "Review of Stallions".
- Due to the nature of the presentation and limitation of scheduled time, use of equipment (jumps, props, etc.) is <u>strongly</u> discouraged.
- **Music** may be used to accompany your presentation. Do not send music in advance, bring it with you to the show and make sure the correct announcer has your music prior to your performance each day. Make sure the music is clearly marked with your stallion name and the tract to be played is clearly noted. Announcers and staff will <u>not</u> be responsible for errors with music and will not be responsible for taking your music to the arena each day. Music is best provided on a thumb drive with the music actually downloaded (not a link to where you found it). Playing from phones does not always work because not all phones are now equipped to plug into the sound system directly. We can also use a CD.
- You may not utilize your own announcer.
- Any group/individual not providing a script by the deadline will be charged \$25.00. Scripts received after February 20 will be charged an additional \$50.
- No changes or substitutions of the script will be permitted at the event.

Arrival, Departure & Stabling

- Stalls will be available beginning at 8:00 A.M. on Thursday.
- Check in with the area coordinator upon arrival to get your stall assignment and pick up your packet containing information and event passes.
- All horses are to arrive no later than 8:00 AM on Friday "Stallion Review" areas must be completed and horses stalled in stalls provided by the facility (no substitutions accepted) by 8:00 am Friday. Doors will open to the public at 10:00 A.M. and it will be both difficult and dangerous to move horses through the crowd at that time.
- All horses must stay on the event grounds till 6:00 PM Sunday. Early departures will not be eligible for stall awards and may not be permitted to return in future years. The Quality of our show is due largely to the quality of our exhibitors. Breaking down your area early is disrespectful to the paying attendees, your neighbors and to show management. Partial or complete dismantling of displays or removal of horses before 6:00 P.M. on Sunday is prohibited.
- Admission to the grounds will be with official tickets/passes only beginning Friday morning. Exhibitors without the proper tickets/passes will have to pay full price at the admission gates. This includes exhibitors staying on grounds.
- Your area should be properly staffed at all times during exhibit hours and kept clean and neat.
- For safety reasons, horses are to remain in their stalls at all times, with the exception of preparation for the scheduled demonstration.
- You must comply with all fire & life safety requirements set forth by the City of Albany Fire dept. and the Linn Co. Fair & Expo Center.
- NO PETS are permitted at The Northwest Horse Fair & Expo only certified assist animals in accordance with the ADA are permitted. Although we love pets too, for the safety of the public, the horses and especially your pets, do not bring them with you. Crowds make it very hazardous for your pet, and we would hate for your beloved to be injured.
- Failure to follow these guidelines can result in denial of participation at The Northwest Horse Fair & Expo in future years.

Stall Decorations & Awards

- The stall and hospitality area must be decorated. Tables, chairs, etc.... are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- Bedding (shavings) may be provided on a limited basis.
- Awards will be given for the "Best Dressed" stall/hospitality area with five or more participants in the

venue. Decorations should be complete by 10:00 am Friday.

Program Opportunity

Participants in the Stallion Review may purchase an ad in the official program and will receive 15% off the cost of the ad space of a half page or larger advertisement (discount does not apply to typesetting fees). Ad must be purchased in the same name that appears on the Stallion Review application.

The contact person on the application is responsible for communicating the above listed rules and guidelines to all participants prior to the event. Read also enclosed Northwest Horse Fair & Expo Rules, Regulations and General Information, as these rules apply.

At the discretion of the Northwest Horse Fair & Expo this event may be videotaped and/or photographed for promotional use. By participating in this event, participants give permission to be videotaped and photographed and release all such material for publicity or promotional use.
